Friday 8 a.m.–1 p.m.

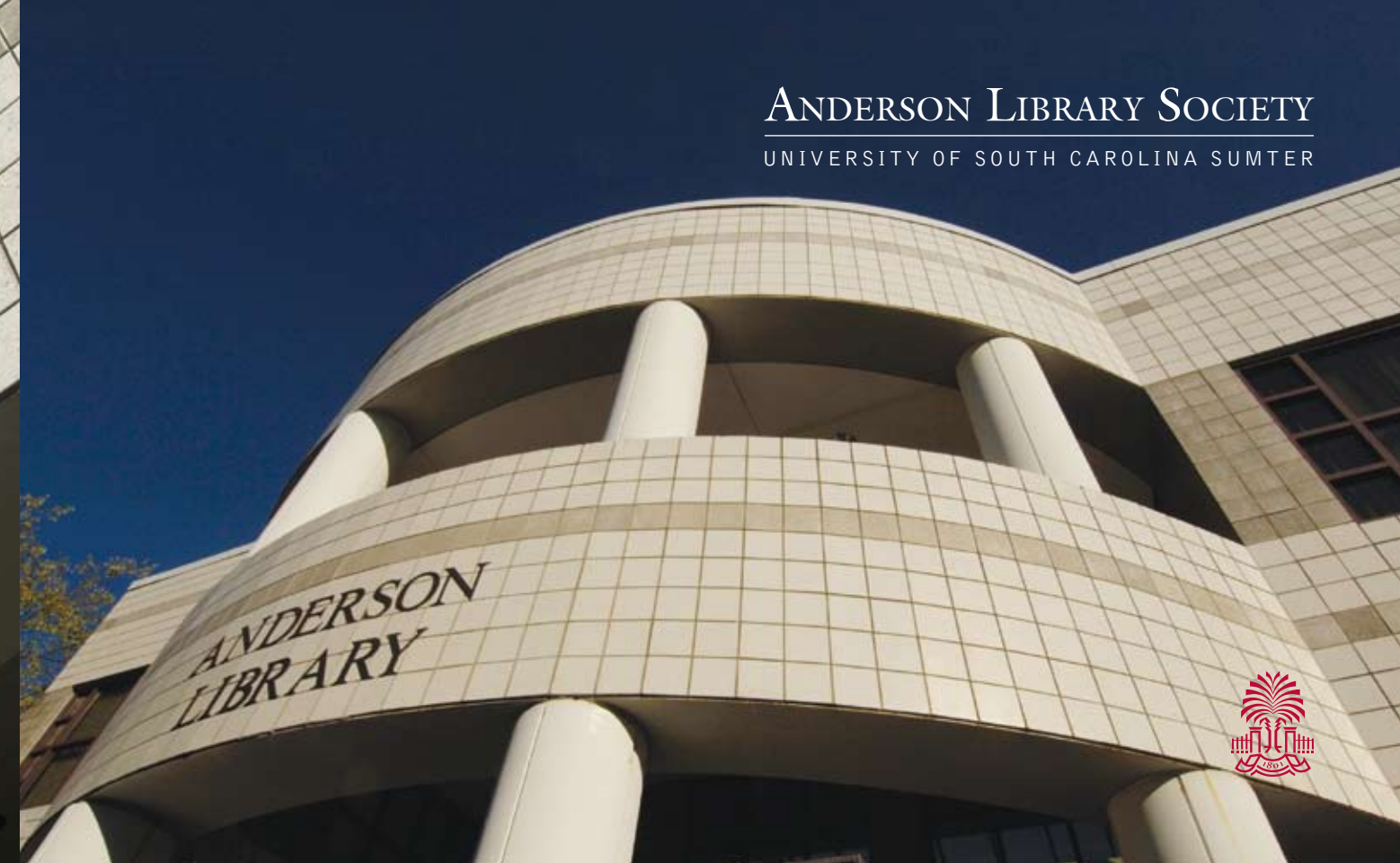
Saturday Closed
