

Raising Your GPA to a 2.0 **What will it take?**

To determine how many hours of “B” course work you will need to earn in order to raise your GPA to a minimum 2.0, use the following formula.

Number of Semester Hours (**GH – Grade Hours**) of graded course work
you have completed _____

Multiplied by 2 x 2 = _____

Subtract the total **Grade Points (GP)** earned to date - GP = _____

This is the total number of Semester Hours of “B” course work
you must complete to raise your GPA to a 2.0 _____

As an example, from your transcript if you have 44 Semester
Grade Hours and 62 total Grade Points, you would calculate as follows:

$$44 \times 2 = 88$$

$$88 - 62 = 26 \text{ hours of “B” work to raise your GPA to a 2.0}$$
